

Terms and Conditions

RESERVATIONS

Wildlife Safari requires a deposit of \$500 to confirm your safari with balance of payment due sixty days prior to your departure date. Reservations will be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date with full loss of deposit. Changes to existing reservations will result in a fee of \$50.00 and any changes made within sixty days of the tour departure date will be charged at the cancellation penalties outlined. Airline tickets and tour documents will be sent about two weeks prior to departure.

CANCELLATIONS

All cancellations must be received in writing by Wildlife Safari and all cancellations will be charged a cancellation penalty depending on the number of days before tour departure:

Cancellations more than 60 days

No refund of deposit

Cancellations less than 60 days

No refund of land cost

Some safaris may incur additional cancellation fees. There is no refund for any unused portions of your safari once it is commenced. Cancellation penalties on airfares are additional and are not included in the above cancellation charges. Cancellation insurance for the total tour cost is suggested and may be purchased from Wildlife Safari.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Airfares quoted in this brochure are current at 1 November, 2006 and may change without notice prior to ticketing. Wildlife Safari is not responsible for any changes in airline schedules, airfares, cancellations, loss or damage to baggage and overbooking. All claims for any loss or injury suffered on any airline must be made directly with the airline concerned and not Wildlife Safari.

The accommodations described in this brochure may not always be available and may be substituted for comparable standard. Single rooms may not be available in certain situations due to limited capacity of hotels.

Tour costs are based on all known costs and rates of exchange at 1 November, 2006, and any significant changes beyond the control of Wildlife Safari will be passed to passengers. Tour costs also include expenses incurred by Wildlife Safari for printing and distribution, advertising, sales and marketing, promotion and administration, provision of toll free reservation service, and a commission to the travel agent who handles your reservations and assists you with obtaining necessary visas.

Wildlife Safari reserves the right to alter any arrangements due to local conditions. Wildlife Safari also retains the right to refuse any person from participating or continuing any tour for any reason or if that person causes or is deemed to cause hazard and/or inconvenience to other passengers or Wildlife Safari.

STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

Wildlife Safari and its agents shall not be responsible or liable for any injury, loss, damage, delay or inconvenience arising out of, or in connection with, any defect in any vehicle or any act, including any acts of terrorism, industrial action, acts of governments and God, omission, neglect, accident, error or omission in the provision of any services. Any travel involves some measure of personal risk that the passenger has to determine. Wildlife Safari reserves the right to accept or decline any passenger from participating on any of our tour programs for any reason. Every passenger must complete a Passenger Registration Form as well as an Indemnity & Assumptions of Risk Statement before final documents are issued.
